#### **ANNOUNCEMENT: BED RAILS USE & SURVEY**

#### **Upcoming Changes: Removal of Bed Siderails**

As part of updated federal regulations aimed at enhancing resident safety and preventing injury, all long-term care facilities are now required to remove bed siderails unless they are specifically medically necessary and meet strict documentation and monitoring criteria.

Effective immediately, we are beginning the phased removal of bed siderails throughout the facility. This decision reflects our commitment to resident safety and regulatory compliance. Our nursing and therapy teams will be working closely with residents and families to ensure this transition is safe and comfortable for everyone. Alternatives such as transfer poles, wall handles, different mattresses, body pillows, staff assistance, and individualized care plans will be used to support safety and dignity

If you have questions or concerns about how this may affect your loved one, please reach out to our nursing or social services team.

## Cupcakes with Dr. Calkins



## Beanies Diner Buting


